

Assistive Listening Devices at the Melbourne Town Hall

The main auditorium and the Swanston hall are now equipped with assistive listening systems, this equipment enables individuals with limited hearing to receive a direct audio feed through a FM receiver. The system operates by sending out (transmitting) a FM signal within the auditorium that is picked up by a FM receiver. 16 individual receivers are available, with either an earphone or a neck loop* attachment.

*A neck loop attachment allows individuals with a hearing aid equipped with a "T Switch" to get a direct feed of the audio production within the hall.

This system will be permanently available within the main auditorium and Swanston hall. The system can be made available within other rooms upon request.
